We encourage any initiative that looks to standardise and formalise arrangements. RWE npower was involved in the development of this portfolio extract and are keen to see that it is introduced into formal governance to ensure that all existing and new entrants use the same extract.

Receiving such data in a standardised format will allow Shippers/Suppliers to develop systems and processes to conduct regular reconciliations. We consider that it is crucial that the data held within the iGT industry is accurate and robust, and believe that this portfolio extract will enable Shippers/Suppliers to effectively manage the quality of data within their portfolio. It is worth noting that the quality of data affects and underpins the customer facing processes such as Customer Transfer and Customer Billing.
