### Facilitation of the relevant objectives

This proposal will facilitate “the securing of effective competition between relevant shippers and suppliers” by ensuring that all participants have full transparency and a good degree of predictability of the modification process.

It will enable smaller participants to resource-plan their participation throughout the year by having a clear timetable indicating when proposals will be released for impact assessment, which Panel meeting will manage those modifications and the planned timetable for the entire process. It will enable them to brief their Panel representatives adequately in advance of the Panel meeting enabling their views to be fully represented.

It will also ensure the “efficient administration of the network code” in that a coordinated release schedule of change documentation will ensure that Pipeline Operators are able to target their resources more accurately in the management of changes to the network code.

### Additional Information and Comments

E.ON believes that full participation in the modification process is important and by having a planned timetable for release of modifications and their subsequent journey as is deployed in the MRA, BSC and SPAA will enable participants to target their scarce resources effectively, ensuring that opportunities to respond to consultations can be maximised.

E.ON believes that the iGTs themselves recognise the value in this approach, since the iGT

Representatives have recently started to take a similar approach to that which was discussed by the workgroup last year, and this modification will effectively codify the arrangements and improve on them.
